Prime Minister Boris Johnson reflected after chairing an emergency COBRA meeting this afternoon that the virus is "likely to become more significant in the days and weeks ahead", making business resilience planning a priority.

To this end, WLB has a Coronavirus Business Support resource, which the team are constantly updating with the latest information from the WHO, UK Government and other relevant sources, such as ACAS and Resilience First. This particularly focusses on resources suitable for businesses, including HR guidance.

WEST LONDON AT MIPIM 2020

Over the weekend the organisers of the MIPIM property conference, Reed MIDEM, decided to postpone MIPIM 2020 until early June 2020 as a precaution against the Coronavirus outbreak.
