The tragic loss of Jo Cox MP has rightly paused the referendum campaign as we reflect on Jo's life and work, and mourn the immense loss to her family, friends and our parliamentary democracy.



EU Referendum

On Thursday 23 June, we will make the biggest decision in a generation. Whilst at a community level the debate has generally been courteous, there have rightly now been calls for a more respectful tone to the national debate in its final days.

If you are still undecided, whilst forecast models all have their uncertainties, for more hard data on the 'here and now' to inform your decision you may find helpful 'EU Economics | EU Referendum - A close call' slide pack full of insights from Morgan Stanley Research. The data highlights the sheer complexity of the multiple factors the electorate are being asked to weigh up. You can also still download the results of WLB's member poll.

Q2 2016: Looking back
